5 Things to Know for June 24, 2021

1. **Your WACD dues invoice being sent now**

Your conservation district should be receiving the annual dues statement from WACD very shortly. That statement contains a pleasant surprise: a reduction in dues for each member district of \$400. WACD had an exceptional year! You will also find a message from WACD Executive Director Tom Salzer with your dues invoice.

2. **WACD adopts new budget for fiscal year 2021-2022**

On Monday, the WACD Board of Directors adopted a new budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022). The Board authorized a \$400 reduction in dues for member districts. That results in an \$18,000 reduction in revenue so WACD will pull from investment gains to cover. WACD also envisions travel to more in-person meetings in FY 21-22, resulting in higher costs. At this time, WACD anticipates holding the 2021 WACD annual conference virtually with an in-person annual business meeting. Stay tuned for more as this develops!

3. **Thank you, Joe and John, as you take up new roles**

Joe Williams has accepted a position with NRCS's National Soil Health Division based out of the West National Technology Support Center in Portland, Oregon. John George is relocating to serve as the Nature Resource Conservation Service's American Indian Liaison in Nevada.

WACD extends best wishes to Joe and John and thanks them for their great service in Washington State.
