WACD is partnering with the <u>Washington Conservation Society</u> (WCS) to share grant opportunities! Please note that some funders require your conservation district to use a 501(c)3 entity as a fiscal agent (also called a <u>fiscal sponsor</u>). Conservation districts can choose to partner with the WCS or another non-profit if a fiscal agent is needed.
