• <u>Current Assets – PMC</u>: PMC assets (checking and savings) at Banner Bank are \$153,312.56 and PMC Savings at Edward Jones is \$206,021.16.

In October, PMC received another check from the IRS for the refund of our 2018 990T (for a total of \$20,556.53). Jim contacted the contacted the IRS about the refund for the taxes we paid on our 2018 990T and the IRS said that we did not owe any taxes that year, so they refunded it, in full, with interest. Keaton is unsure why the IRS says we do not owe any taxes. The refund check from the IRS for the 2018 990T was deposited with Edward Jones and added to the money market account that was set up to deposit the refund check from the IRS for the double refund of the 2016 backup withholding tax. The money market is invested in US securities and is earning 1.8% annually.
