There are two savings accounts at Edward Jones (under Current Assets – PMC). One account is identified as IRS Deposits (\$53,296.38). This money is a refunded from the IRS for payment on the 990-T. Our previous accountant, believes that these funds are owed to the IRS, however the IRS thinks we owe nothing. We are collaborating with our new accountant to resolve this issue.

The other account is identified as PMC Savings. Within this account, \$133,658.71 is a deposit on plants for 2023. This amount is also listed as a current liability until the plants are delivered in the Spring of 2023. If something happens that prevents us from supplying the plants, the money will need to be refunded.
